The Rev. Ann Coburn Elected Vice-Chair, Board of Directors of the Evangelical Education Society of the Episcopal Church

Berkeley, CA -- Church Divinity School of the Pacific is pleased to announce that the Rev. Ann Coburn, '77, has been elected as Vice-Chair of the Board of Directors of the Evangelical Education Society (EES) of the Episcopal Church.

“EES gives Episcopal seminarians and others connected to our seminaries the opportunity to think outside the box and to fulfill dreams. It doesn't get much better than that,” said Coburn.

The Rev. Ann S. Coburn is the Director of Alumni/ae and Church Relations at CDSP. A graduate of CDSP, she was ordained in 1977 and spent 28 years in parish ministry in Connecticut, Rhode Island, and Massachusetts before returning to the west coast in 2005. She has served on the Executive Council of the Episcopal Church and was a six-time deputy to General Convention.

CDSP is a founding member of the Graduate Theological Union, an ecumenical and interfaith consortium based in Berkeley, Calif.
